## **Tabbed Interfaces**

As databases become larger it is impossible to show all the data on the one data entry screen. To overcome this problem fields can be placed in hidden regions on a layout and those regions opened by clicking on a tab. It is called a TABBED INTERFACE. The tabs act like buttons.

In this case we will add simplified tabbed sections to the bottom of the LIBRARY ENTRY layout that you used in the last chapter.


- 1 Load FileMaker Pro 10, click on OPEN DATABASE and select BROWSE FILES. Or close the current file and select OPEN from the FILE menu.
- 2 Access your FMP10 FILES folder and open:



### Inserting the Tab Control

The TAB CONTROL TOOL from the STATUS TOOLBAR is used to create the TABBED INTERFACE.


1 The screen should be set to the LIBRARY ENTRY layout.







# **Defining the Tab Sections**

All the sections of the TABBED INTERFACE are entered in the TAB CONTROL SETUP dialogue box.






2 In the TAB NAME box enter: Subject Details and click on CREATE to create the second tab.



3 In the TAB NAME box enter:


Order Details

and click on CREATE to create the third tab.



4 The TAB labels are displayed in the TAB frame. Leave TAB JUSTIFICATION as LEFT, APPEARANCE as ROUNDED, the TAB WIDTH as LABEL WIDTH then select OK.

- NOTE: i The TAB LABELS can be set to be centred, right or full justified.
  - ii The appearance of the tabs can be set to rounded or straight.
  - iii The arrows next to the tab labels in the TABS frame can be used to change the order of the tabs.
